

Homecoming 2009 Chill-n-Grill

PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES

The following procedures and guidelines are to provide for the health, safety and well being of Tailgater while allowing for the enjoyment of all. Anyone violating these procedures will be asked to leave the Chill-n-Grill. Any violations of university, city, state, or federal policies, procedures, ordinances or laws may be subject to prosecution under the respective authorities.

General Rules

- All Tailgating groups must register with the Chill-N-Grill Committee.
- All Tailgating Vehicles must be registered and display the tailgating permit.
- Tailgaters should arrive no sooner than 12:00 p.m. and no later than 1:00 p.m. on February 7, 2009.
- Tailgaters should proceed to the corner of Floyd and Harrison Streets to be checked in and receive their parking permit.
- Tailgaters parked in the VV lot must move their vehicles no later than 7 a.m. Sunday, February 8, 2009.
- Tailgaters parked on Floyd Ave. must move their vehicle by 11 p.m. Saturday, February 7, 2009.
- Electricity will not be available for Tailgaters.
- Tailgaters will be responsible for cleaning up their area.

Permitted

- Propane and charcoal grills.
- Personal Vehicles (limit 1 per space)
- Coolers, ice chest, etc.
- Personal stereo and/or car stereo systems
- Spirit Displays (Car decorations, etc.)
- Outdoor furniture (no couches, loveseats, etc.)

Not Permitted

- Liquid Fuel Grills
- Open fires not in approved grill.
- Glass containers
- Kegs or multi serving containers of alcohol.
- Car Stereo Systems which can be heard beyond the immediate vicinity of the vehicle.
- Gasoline Generators.
- Drinking games, funnels, and or other activities that encourage binge drinking are not permitted.

SPECIAL ALCOHOL RULES

- Alcohol may be possessed and consumed within the tailgate area by persons that are or are above the legal drinking age of 21.
- All individuals who are of legal drinking age that desire to drink must have their identification checked upon entrance to the tailgate area.
- All individuals of legal drinking age who desire to drink at the event must wear the event specific wristband denoting that they are of legal drinking age on their wrist at all times during the event.
- Open alcohol containers outside of the tailgate area will be subject to open container laws of the City of Richmond and are prohibited.
- Single serving alcohol containers for personal consumption in cans or plastic only.
